Dear Mr. Ochwat

I would like to inform you that OLAF’s external investigation into the reported allegations of irregularities and fraud in the context of the above EU-funded project has now been completed.

Based on the findings presented by the Investigation Team, OLAF’s Executive Board has recommended on 04.08.2009 that the above case be closed without further follow-up. However, it should be stressed that OLAF has recommended that the total amount of EU-funds (22.785,34 €) received by the Polish Museum of Railway and Industry – acting as subcontractor of the Wrocław University of Technology in the CONSIST Project – be recovered by the European Commission. Therefore, the final case report which contains this recommendation, has been forwarded to the Directorate-General for Research.
